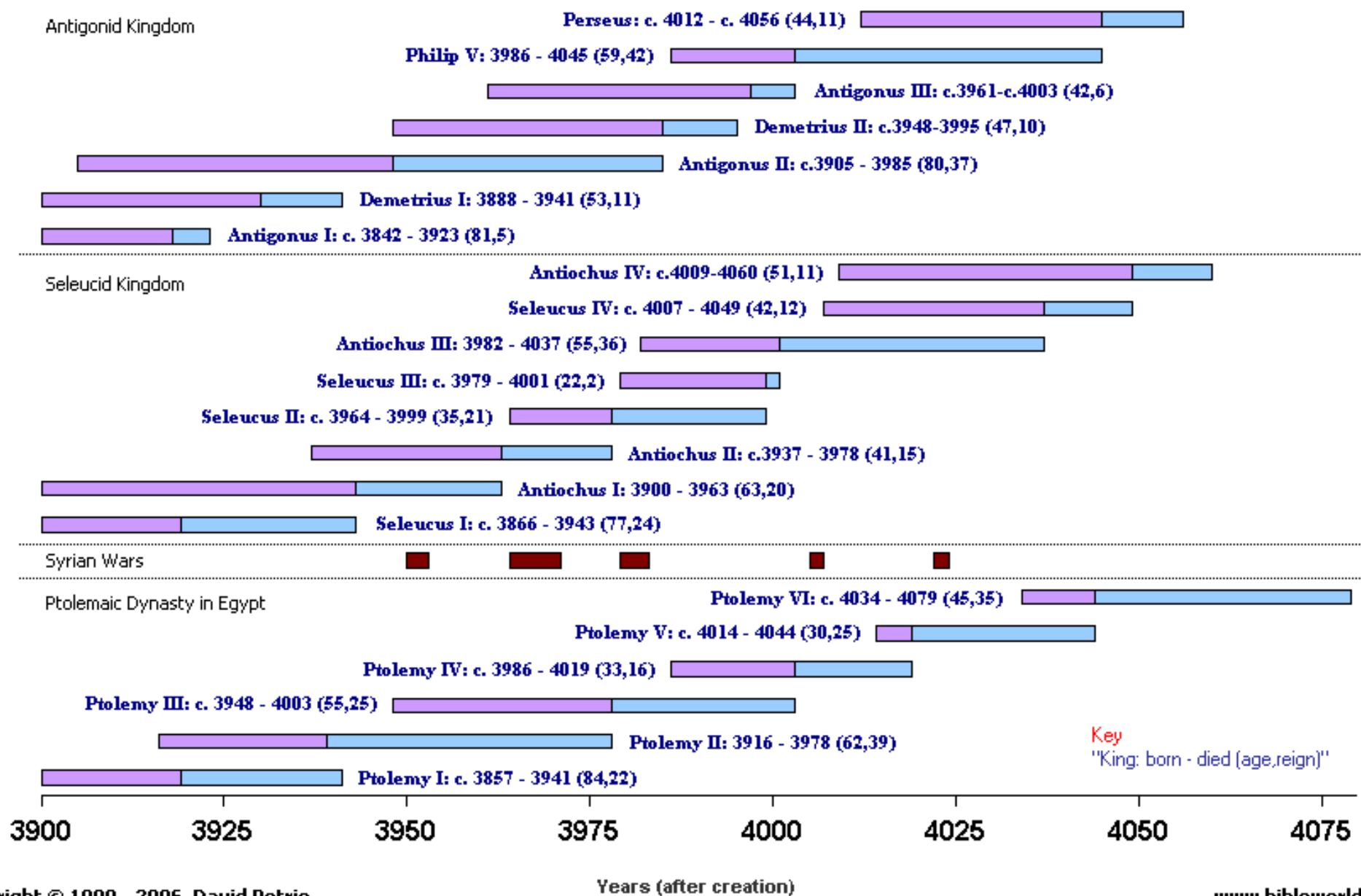
Greece: Alexander the Great

(and the Diadochoi - Successors to Alexander)

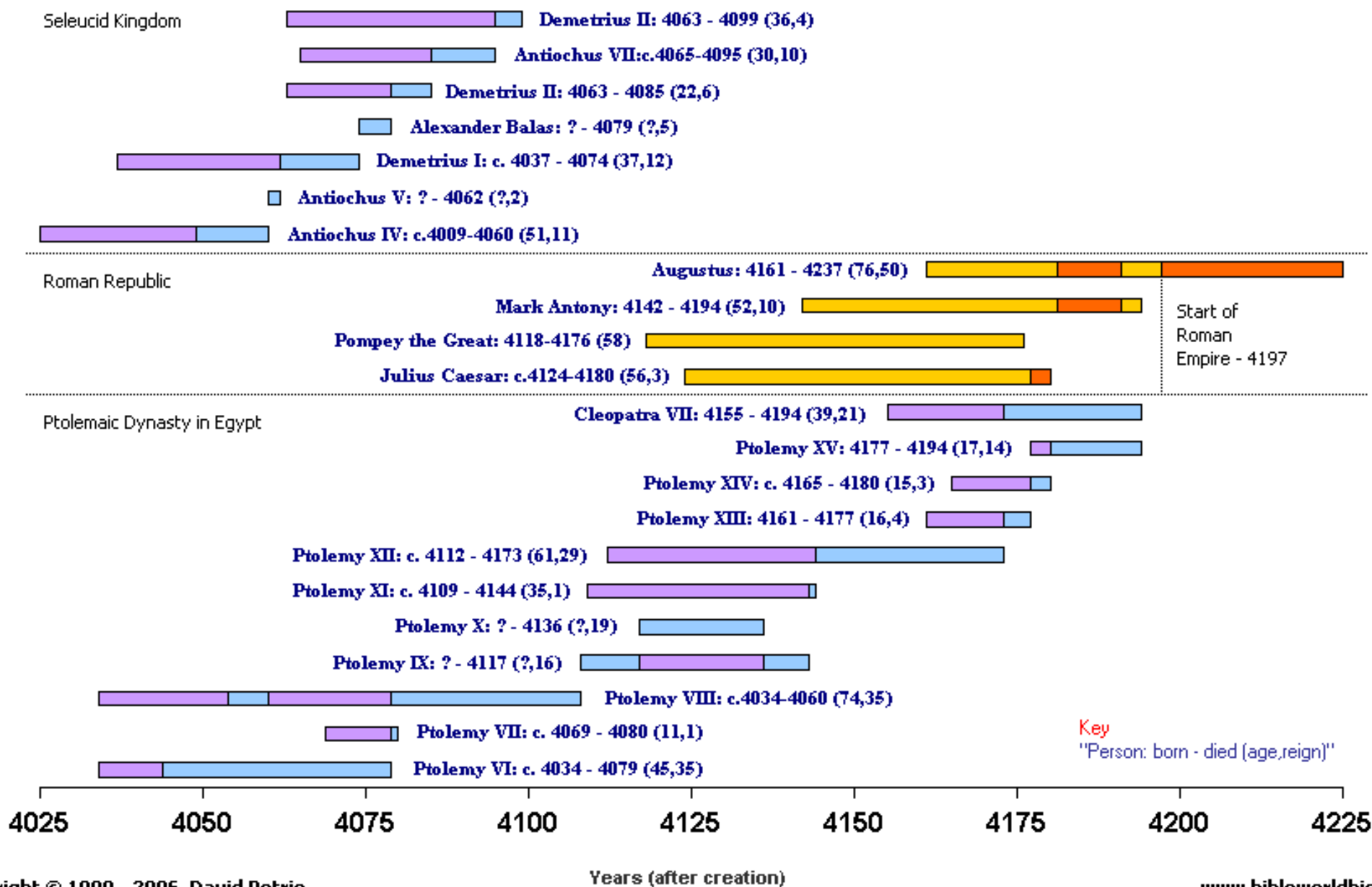
Other Generals who served under Alexander the Great, and were killed before establishing territories of their own



Greece: Early Hellenism

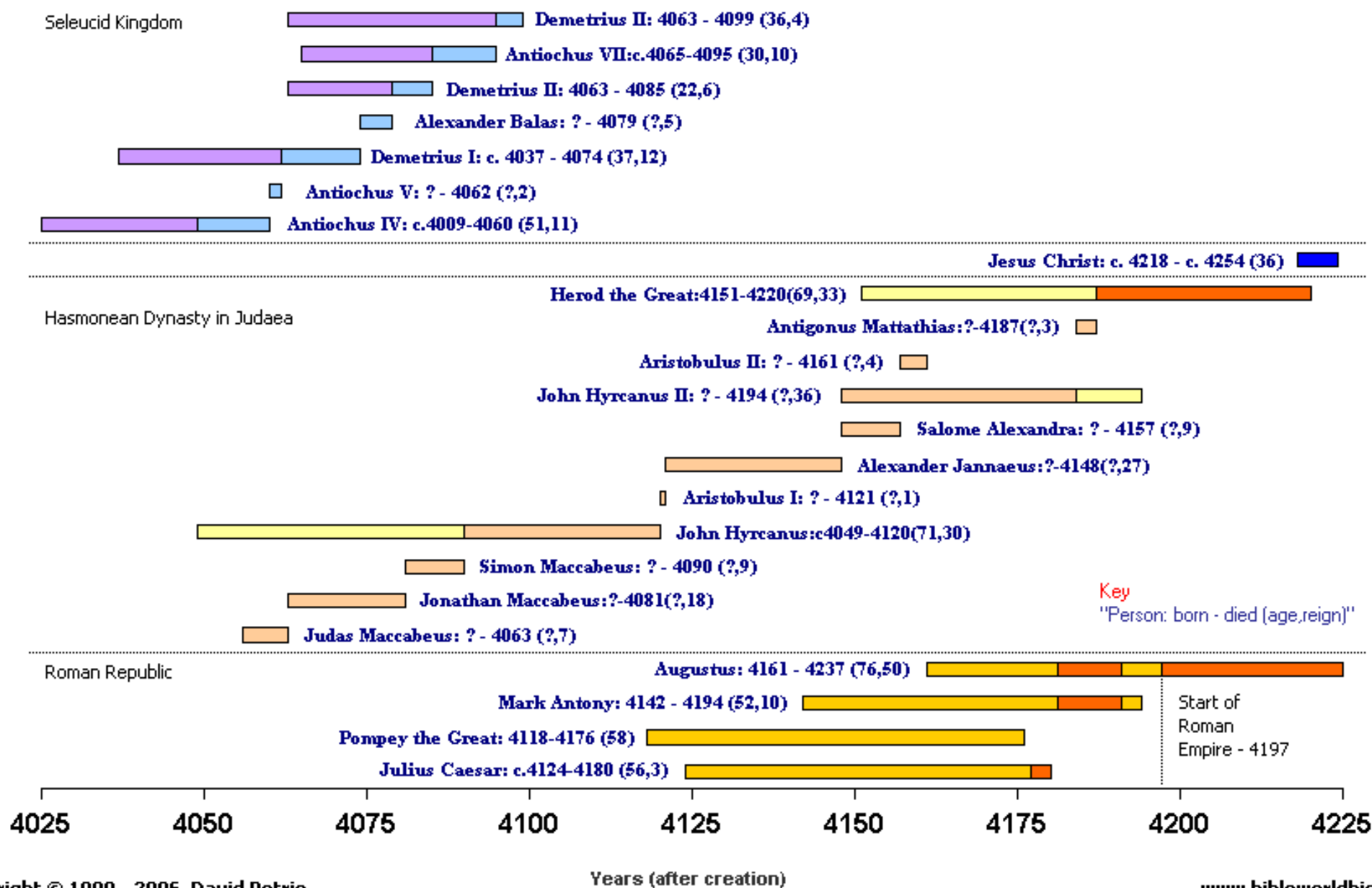


Greece: Late Hellenism
